

## Reference Guidelines:

If it is a webpage, put the address at the end of the sentence as the reference and make it a link ([www.science.com](http://www.science.com))

If it is a journal article or book that has an electronic format, reference it at the end of the sentence (Jimmy et al 2009) and then make the reference an active link to the abstract in pubmed or the article at the journal's website.

If it is a book or journal article with no electronic format, then use the footnoting part of the wiki page.

In general try not to have:
